

# f.a.q. FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS ?

## What is a Disciple Now weekend?

Dnow is a weekend of small group Bible studies, food, and fun. We place students into small groups that stay in peoples homes here in the area. These small groups are made up of like age and gender students, and are led by older group leaders that we have invited to stay and share with each group. The weekend begins on Friday night with a meal at the FLC and concludes with a special dnow church service on Sunday.

## Dnow Group Activities

**Derby Race:** It's been a long time, the Derby Race is back! Each group will 'build' a race car for this special event. They will have a 'driver' and pushers for the race. These positions and everyone has to take 'pit stops' on their race. This is great team building event and one that can be entertaining to spectators.

**Friday and Saturday Worship:** This year we have a made some changes and have both a Friday and Saturday worship event. Marcus Elliot and band will be leading and Shane Norton will be speaking both nights.

## What if I want to go, but the cost is a problem?

Never, Never, I repeat **NEVER**, let money stand in the way of attending an event! We have scholarships available. In the registration sheet please check the appropriate box.

## What if I want to come but I have a conflict?

First, evaluate whether this conflict ranks ahead of what you will be missing during the weekend. Dnow happens only once a year, and a weekend is a very brief amount of time. It is recommended, if the time that you will be away is more than the time you will be involved, that you do not attend the weekend. If you do attend and need to be away, please fill out the time away information on the registration form.

## How will I know which home I will be staying at?

We release the information on our Website on Thursday morning before the weekend.

## How can my parents find directions to the home I will be staying?

This information will also be given to you on the Wednesday night kick-off rally. All necessary information will be available on our website [www.fbcva.com/dnow](http://www.fbcva.com/dnow). This will include: a listing of students and the home they are staying in, and maps and contact information for each home.

## Can I drive during the weekend?

A student can drive their vehicle to the host home on Friday night (no passengers). The keys will be taken up by the host home parent. Unless that student has a signed time-away card they will not be allowed to drive during the weekend.

## What do I need to bring

Sleeping bag / bedroll, Pillow, Toiletries, Bible, Casual Clothes, Sleeping Clothes, Towel, Clothes for Sunday Morning, jeans are OK (everyone will wear their Dnow T-shirt.)

## What does my registration include?

The cost includes Bible study materials, food, and a dnow t-shirt, great leaders, speakers, and worship band.
